2. Health attestation

I, the undersigned official veterinarian certifies that:

(1) Captive or wild mammals exported to the Republic of Korea from Japan (hereinafter referred to as "animals for export") were born and have been raised at least for more than 6 months prior to shipment in Japan.

(2) Japan is free from infection with rabies virus according to OIE terrestrial code.

(3) The raising facility of animals for export is registered according to relevant regulations of Japan. It is monitored by the competent Japanese authority and approved by the animal quarantine agency of the Republic of Korea in advance.

(4) The raising facility maintains and keeps records of types of exported animals, the number of animals, country of origin or capture, date of introduction of new animals, status of animal diseases, drug treatment, clinical testing, rabies neutralization antibody testing (if any), etc.

- (5) The raising facility regularly plans and operates inspection programs to check the presence of livestock infectious diseases, and the results of inspections conducted by the exporting country government were favorable.
- (6) There has been no outbreak of tuberculosis for the past two years, and rabies or plague for the past one year in the raising facility.
- (7) Animals for export were isolated for a period of at least 30 days prior to shipment for the export inspection at the export quarantine facility approved by a government veterinary officer. There has been no clinical evidence of any contagious disease during the isolation period. Animals for export did not come in contact with other animals except for animals for export after the export quarantine procedures are initiated.

- (9) Animals for export showed no clinical signs of symptoms of rabies according to clinical tests conducted by a veterinary officer of the government of the exporting country on the day of shipment or the day before.
- (10) The loading space of transport boxes and vehicles used for export quarantine facility and transportation of animals for export were disinfected with disinfectants approved by the competent Japanese authority before entering or using for animals for export. Animals for export are transported by safe method for animals.
- (11) Hay, straw and feed used in transporting of animals for export are clean and not contaminated with pathogens of livestock diseases and no additional hay, straw and feed are allowed during transportation of exported animals.
- (12) Animals for export are not in contact with other susceptible animals that are not subject to export quarantine during transportation to the Republic of Korea.
